**NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY**

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Sunday, March 14, 2021:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Matthew F. Kennelly: As predicted by the Court during recent status hearings in this case, the jury trial date of 4/26/2021 is vacated at Court's instance and reset to 5/3/2021 at 9:30 AM. This is due to a conflict with a scheduled trial before the Court in a criminal case involving a defendant who is in custody. As discussed on previous occasions with counsel, the actual start date for the trial in this case may be any day during the week of 5/3/2021 and will be set at least 14 days before 5/3/2021 and likely more. Prospective jurors, trial counsel, and witnesses who will be present in court for more than two days will be required to report two business days before the start date of the trial for coronavirus testing and will be subject to retesting at three-to-four-day intervals during the trial depending on its length. The number of hours allocated to the trial and to each side will be the same as for the November 2021 trial in this case, but reduced by the amount of time already spent addressing deposition designations and objections as set out in the minute entry of 11/3/2020 (dkt. no. 456), subject to the potential for further adjustment as described in that entry and in the Court's earlier order regarding trial time allocation.
