

ORAL ORDER re 152 Statement Regarding European Depositions - Having reviewed the parties' joint status report, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that 1) The parties shall continue to monitor the quarantine and travel restrictions over the next 30 days and provide a status report to the Court no later than November 20, 2020 and 2) Plaintiff may request a deposition of the witnesses pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 31. Any such deposition shall be subject to Local Rule 30.6, with the "commencement" of the written deposition being when Defendants' counsel receives the written questions and the "conclusion" of the deposition being when Defendants' counsel serves the response on Plaintiff's counsel. Defendants' counsel may submit written objections of no more than five words each to any question. Obtaining a deposition under Rule 31 will NOT be grounds for Defendants to oppose another deposition live should conducting a deposition live become feasible.
