

Judge Indira Talwani: ELECTRONIC ORDER cancelling Rule 16 conference. In light of the public health emergency as declared by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in response to the spread of the coronavirus and COVID-19, the advice of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to take precautions to reduce the possibility of exposure to the virus and slow the spread of the disease, General Order 20-2 issued by Chief Judge Saylor to protect public health and reduce unnecessary travel, and the parties Rule 16 Joint Statement 17 setting forth no disagreements as to a proposed scheduling order, the court is cancelling the Rule 16 conference set for March 23, 2020, and issuing a written scheduling order. Any party may request a rescheduled Rule 16 conference or a status conference by motion or by email to the courtroom deputy clerk, with a copy to all counsel. Pursuant to the Rule 16 Joint Statement 17 , the court will refer this matter to mediation before a magistrate judge. Counsel shall jointly notify the clerk by email when the initial exchanges of documents and information referenced in the Joint Statement has been completed. (MacDonald, Gail) (Entered: 03/17/2020)
