The **UK Supreme Court** refuses Ryanair permission to appeal the UK report requiring it to sell-down its 30% stake in Aer Lingus.

UK Competition Appeal Tribunal dismisses Ryanair's appeal against UK sell-down order.

U.S. Department of Justice closes investigation of IAG/Aer Lingus merger.

Ryanair votes in support of IAG takeover.
