05/11/2020		<p>ORAL ORDER: At the present time, Judge Fallon has decided to conduct the mediation scheduled for June 22, 2020 telephonically. The logistics of the telephonic mediation shall be as follows: Plaintiffs counsel shall make arrangements for a dial-in number for all counsel, including the Judge, to use throughout the mediation process when the mediation begins. This line should be available throughout the mediation should the Judge wish to have discussions with all parties. Plaintiffs counsel shall also arrange for a separate line for their private discussions with the Judge throughout the mediation process. Defense counsel shall arrange for a separate line for their private discussions with the Judge throughout the mediation process. These lines should remain open for use by counsel and the Court until the mediation is concluded. Plaintiffs counsel shall provide all of the dial-in information by email to Judge Fallon, with a copy to her Courtroom Deputy, Ms. Hicks, by 12:00 Noon Eastern Thursday, June 18, 2020. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court has issued a Standing Order dated 3/13/20 regarding paper documents coming into the Court. This would include mediation statements. Therefore, until further notice, counsel shall be permitted to email mediation statements to Judge Fallon, with a copy to Ms. Hicks on their due date. Since the Judge is permitting the email of the statements, they shall still be due on the date and time (EST) specified in the Mediation Scheduling Order. Counsel are cautioned to limit the number of exhibits to the statements being emailed. Exhibits shall be single-sided only. Should the exhibits exceed 50 pages, then in that instance, two copies of the exhibits only shall be hand delivered to the Clerks Office IN AN ENVELOPE addressed to Judge Fallon, stating the name of the case and marked Confidential Mediation Material by no later than 3:00 p.m. Eastern Time. If the exhibits are not in an envelope, the Clerks Office will be instructed not to accept them.
