**ORDER GRANTING IN PART  
DEFENDANTS' EX PARTE  
MOTION TO MODIFY CASE  
MANAGEMENT ORDER**

[ECF No. 76]

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18 Before the Court is Defendants' *ex parte* motion to modify the case management  
19 order. ECF No. 76. Plaintiff filed an opposition and Defendants filed a reply. ECF Nos.  
20 82, 83. After due consideration, the Court **GRANTS IN PART** the motion and extends  
21 certain dates as discussed below.

22 Defendants request that the Court modify the scheduling order, extending most  
23 remaining dates including pretrial and trial dates, by several months. ECF No. 76. They  
24 argue that the extension would better reflect the realistic schedule for this case to  
25 proceed, giving delays due to Covid-19. *Id.* at 3. Defendants argue that a more accurate  
26 trial date is an important factor that will be considered by the U.S. Patent and Trademark  
27 Office ("PTAB") in deciding whether or not to institute their currently pending *inter*  
28 *partes* review ("IPR") proceedings. *Id.* at 4-6. Plaintiff objects, arguing that the current

1 schedule is sufficient to finish discovery and that the IPR issue should not dictate the  
2 schedule in this case. ECF No. 82.

3 The Court agrees that the scheduling order in this matter will not be dictated by the  
4 effect it would have on the pending IPR proceedings. However, the case status at this  
5 juncture does warrant a small extension. Defendants' motion to stay is currently pending  
6 before the Court (ECF No. 48), and the Court also recently vacated the claim construction  
7 hearing and all related deadlines, to be reset if necessary after a decision on the motion to  
8 stay. ECF No. 81. In order to provide the parties with more time to conduct discovery  
9 while these other issues are determined, the Court will grant an approximate two-month  
10 extension on remaining dates. The Court cautions that the parties must remain diligent in  
11 pursuing discovery even with the extension, particularly as to any issues that will not be  
12 affected by claim construction. Any further extensions would require good cause as to  
13 why the discovery could not have been completed under the schedule.

14 Accordingly, the motion is **GRANTED IN PART** and the scheduling order is  
15 modified as follows:


