**PROCEEDINGS: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER CONTINUING CLAIM
CONSTRUCTION HEARING AND SETTING
TECHNOLOGY TUTORIAL DEADLINE**

The Court issues this ORDER in response to the unforeseeable global pandemic involving the disease coronavirus 2019 (“COVID-19”), caused by the virus SARS-CoV-2 (“the virus”).

On March 23, 2020, the Central District of California activated its Continuity of Operations Plan (“COOP”), currently effective through and including June 1, 2020.¹ Among other measures, the plan suspends hearings in civil cases, except for emergency time-sensitive matters, such as requests for temporary restraining orders and preliminary injunctions, as ordered by the assigned District Judge.

Therefore, the Claim Construction Hearing currently scheduled for May 5, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. is **continued to July 21, 2020, at 9:00 a.m.** As a technology tutorial, the parties are to meet and confer and electronically submit a joint technology presentation that the Court will independently view. The presentation should last no more than an hour and may include PowerPoint slides and/or experts. To the extent the parties disagree on the technology, they may so indicate in the presentation. The parties are to electronically submit their presentation **no later than May 25, 2020**, by saving it using a cloud storage provider of their choice (*e.g.*, Dropbox) and then sending a shared link to the presentation to JLS_Chambers@cacd.uscourts.gov.
