This firm, together with Kasowitz Benson Torres LLP, represents Zydus Pharmaceuticals (USA), Inc. ("Zydus") in the above-captioned action. We write on behalf of defendants Zydus and Aurobindo Pharma USA Inc. ("Aurobindo") to respectfully request a modest one-week extension of time for the parties to file their pretrial briefs and proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law from May 21 to May 28, 2020 (ECF No. 160). We have conferred with counsel for Plaintiffs, and we have been informed that Plaintiffs take no position on this request.

Good cause supports the requested extension. Our lead trial counsel in this matter has been ill and other members of the trial team have had overlapping obligations, including just yesterday the submissions of six expert reports and participation in oral arguments in other matters. Moreover, as Your Honor is aware, Chief Judge Wolfson adjourned the May trial in this case, and there is presently no trial date on schedule.
