ORDER

In their Rule 26(f) Joint Conference Report, the parties have requested that “all deadlines [in this case] be postponed until and recalculated after the Shelter-In-Place Order of the Alameda County Health Officer (where Defendants’ headquarters is located) no longer applies.” (Dkt. #15). The Alameda County’s Shelter-In-Place Order is currently set to expire on May 3, 2020. ALAMEDA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT, SUMMARY OF NEW SHELTER IN PLACE ORDER ISSUED ON MARCH 31, 2020, <http://www.acphd.org/media/563713/summary-updated-shelter-in-place-order-20200331.pdf>.

The Court, having considered the merits and found good cause, GRANTS the request.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that all proceedings and deadlines in this case are stayed through May 3, 2020. It is further **ORDERED** that the parties shall submit an amended Rule 26(f) joint conference report with a proposed case schedule, revised as needed, by no later than May 7, 2020.¹

¹ The Alameda County’s Shelter-In-Place Order states that “new Order will be in effect until May 3, 2020,” but notes that the “date could be changed by the County Health Officer.” Should the County Health Officer extend the Order, the parties may move to further stay this case.
