

ORAL ORDER: The Court, having reviewed the parties August 31, 2020 letter, (D.I. 330), hereby ORDERS as follows with respect to the September 21, 2020 hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction: (1) The hearing will be held via videoconference using the Skype for Business platform. By no later than September 14, 2020, the parties shall send an e-mail to the Court's Courtroom Deputy, Ms. Benyo, indicating the names and e-mail addresses of all individuals who will participate in the hearing.; (2) Three hours will be allocated for the hearing, to be split evenly between the parties.; (3) ClearOne's suggestions with respect to the structure of hearing are adopted. (D.I. 330 at 4-5); (4) ClearOnes unopposed request for a 5-page extension to its sur-reply brief is GRANTED.; and (5) ClearOnes request to introduce additional evidence in its sur-reply brief to directly respond to Shure's arguments in its reply brief is GRANTED for the reasons set out by ClearOne.
