ORDER ON
 JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINES AND RESET MARKMAN HEARING IN


1. All prospective deadlines specified within the Court's Scheduling Order (Dkt. 44) are hereby extended by sixty (60) days. The parties shall submit an appropriately revised proposed Scheduling Order for the Court's consideration at least fourteen (14) days prior to the first such extended deadline.
2. The Clerk is hereby directed to vacate the *Markman* hearing currently scheduled for October 24, 2020 (Dkt. 46). The parties shall contact the Court to reset the hearing for a date convenient for the Court and the parties in December 2020 or January 2021.

3. Neither the fact of the parties having made the Joint Motion (Dkt. No. 48) nor the relief granted herein shall negate or otherwise prejudice any aspect of any claim, defense, or counterclaim of either party.
