

Judge Richard G. Stearns: ELECTRONIC ORDER entered denying 53 Motion to Compel. Uniloc seeks to compel athenahealth to produce its source code for review in Dallas, Texas, the location of its chosen technical expert, who for health reasons in light of the Covid19 pandemic cannot travel to Boston. Athenahealth, for its part, emphasizes that the source code for its cloud services is the company's most valued "crown jewel" and that it has always handled any disclosure of the code with the utmost precautions, and under current circumstances, cannot produce the code in Texas without taking undue risks. Uniloc, in turn, does not wish to engage a different expert from the Boston area. The parties' concerns are reasonable, and neither party should have to bear the cost of the pandemic more than the other. Accordingly, the court adopts athenahealth's proposal to stay the case until 2021. The parties to file a joint statement by 1/11/2021 on the propriety of lifting the stay and plans for the code review. The parties may also seek to lift the stay before that time should they mutually agree on a workable solution. (Tang, Danni) (Entered: 07/29/2020)
