

Minute Entry for proceedings held before Judge Alan D Albright: Discovery Hearing held on 4/20/2021. Case called for Discovery Hearing. The discovery may be in China and, per the defendant's originally it was thought to be on a U.S. server, but now does not appear so. The office in China has shut due to COVID - The Court orders the defendant to have the relevant requested discovery which is not privileged to the plaintiff within two weeks. The plaintiff has time to review and then the defendant shall have a 30(b)(6) witness ready to testify in short order (less than a week) regarding the discovery. If the witness does not have the knowledge needed then the plaintiff can contact the Court again regarding this (Minute entry documents are not available electronically.).
