Their discussion focused on the different career options available to students with PhDs, how to evaluate alternate paths, and the importance of taking into consideration one's personality and strengths when making career-related choices.

"To prepare for a career in law with a science background, I encourage aspiring students to learn about as many diverse areas of how science is utilized in the real world, such as the regulatory aspects of drug development, clinical trials, patents, labeling and the like. The broadest exposure will lead to the broadest opportunities," Auth said.
