Cadwalader Submits Amicus Brief on Behalf of Structured Finance Association (SFA) in Connection with Hertz Bankruptcy

New York, July 17, 2020 — Cadwalader submitted an [amicus brief](#) on behalf of the Structured Finance Association (SFA) position in connection with the Hertz Global Holdings Inc. bankruptcy. The rental car giant filed for Chapter 11 protection in May after its business was heavily impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
